Patenting at IOCB





- On average 10 patent applications/year
- On average 8 patents awarded (plus members of families)/
- On average 7 mil CZK/year spent
- Licenses: 10 executed license agreements in between 2013-2019
- Curent income about 70 mil USD/year
- There exists certain experience and we can compare when speaking with colleagues from other institutions

Typical mistakes





- Pre-publishing (master thesis)
- Last moment patent (2 days prior abstract deadline)
- Patenting in CR only
- Not recognizing that a high quality patent creation will cost money
- Not enough tools and experience to truly analyze the value of the IP
